HOW WILL IT WORK:

Your church provides the project (projects) for up to 20 volunteers. Somebody Cares will evaluate, fund and provide all the materials for your project.

You provide your Somebody Cares/ CareFest coordinator with the projects, your number of volunteers, and their skill levels three weeks prior to your CareFest day.

We will evaluate the project/ projects and get the info back to you. We will set up a date to shop and exchange tools and materials for liability waivers etc.

FAQ'S

What if we can't get a project from within our church?

Let us know and we will furnish you with a project/projects for up to twenty volunteers.

What if we have more than twenty volunteers?

Somebody Cares St. Augustine will fund projects for up to 20 volunteers. If you would like to do more projects that would be great, but your church will be responsible to secure, evaluate, coordinate, and fund the additional projects required.

What if we have tools and materials leftover?

You can drop tools and unused materials off at our warehouse 2206 Century Blvd. Just let us know the day you plan to drop them.

What if we don't get our project done on our CareFest day?

You own the project, so you would just make arrangements with the homeowner to come back and finish when you can.
